Q: Where do I pick-up my registration? At the Osage Casino & Hotel, 951 W. 36TH STREET NORTH TULSA, OK 74127

Q: Can I register on-site? Yes, at the Osage Casino & Hotel, 951 W. 36TH STREET NORTH TULSA, OK 74127

Q: Is registration required? Registration is not required. However, the rally social events on Friday night, the Saturday Day Party and the Saturday Night Party will require registration or an onsite fee for each.

Q: Where will the rally be held? The rally will be held on the northeast side of downtown Tulsa area on the historic Greenwood Ave Street and encompass large footprint. The rally will start at 131 N. Greenwood Ave and extend north down through the historic area.

Q: Does the rally welcome non-black attendees? Everyone is welcome regardless of race, sex, sexuality or political affiliation. The rally will not condone any form of racism, sexism, intolerance, anti-semitism, white supremacy or hate speech.

Q: Does Oklahoma have a helmet law requirement? The state of Oklahoma does not require motorcyclist to wear helmet.

Q: Can you purchase the rally T-shirt and patch onsite? Yes, at the casino registration site and also at the Greenwood rally site.

Q: Where will the free tours take place? Reconciliation Park, Pathway to Hope, Greenwood Cultural Center, Greenwood Rising History Center, Mount Zion Baptist Church. The times will be shared on the final event schedule.

Q: Is camping permitted on rally grounds? No camping permitted. For camping locations see Oklahoma State Parks of approved camping locations in the Tulsa area.

Q: Will there be designated motorcycle parking? Yes, parking will be available in the OSU – Tulsa campus Lot A.

Q: Is this an All-Female Ride event? No, The Lady Riders of Oklahoma are hosting the ride the same weekend to increase the number of activities for riders to enjoy and experience.

Q: Is this a family event? Yes, although most attendees will be adults, families are welcome.
